

Peru has a stable government and tourism has boomed in recent years. With the added tourist dollars, the government has made a concerted effort to keep travelers and their valuables safe. There have been no terrorist attacks in Peruvian tourist areas in over a decade. Travelers should take the same common-sense precautions that they would in any major city such as not going into unfamiliar areas alone, especially at night. Pisac is very safe. Petty theft is common in cities especially in busy tourist areas such as airports, markets, and other tourist sites so be aware of your valuables and don't leave them unattended.
