



Andean music is one of the great treasures of Peru. Experience the traditional pre-Columbian music and dances with flutes, drums, songs, dances and typical costumes. After years of research, <u>Nawpa Nan</u> will take you through a tour of Andean agricultural rituals in a celebration of music and dances that are still practiced in the remote communities of Cusco, Lake Titicaca and other regions.

This rich musical exploration is a deep expression of Andean culture, worldview and values, and is a unique opportunity for visitors who are looking for something real and not a folkloric presentation for tourists.

You will learn why certain instruments are played during specific periods of the year and



understand what their connection is with the cosmic cycles of nature.

To conclude, you will enjoy a Cusco orchestra with harp, violin, mandolin, quena and the high-pitched voices of the women who create a festive atmosphere.
